NEW CASTLE AREA TRANSIT AUTHORITY PARK N' RIDE PROJECTS



The New Castle Area Transit Authority (NCATA) retained R.A.R. to design a Park N' Ride facility for downtown New Castle. Until this point, the NCATA did not have a central transfer facility for its passengers. This project repurposed 3.5 acres of downtown property to allow 25 buses per day to pick up and drop off passengers from eight bus shelters designed for passenger convenience. Due to the success of this facility, additional funds from the ARRA (American Recovery and Reinvestment Act) were secured to develop a sister Park N' Ride on the opposite side of East Washington Street. An additional 56 parking spaces were created with this phase. These projects encouraged ridership throughout Lawrence County and even into the City of Pittsburgh.
